<p>You wanted to mention again your desire for all staff to complete the logging of red and green slips fully, including the subject and reason. As Parents/ Carers this then allows you to facilitate conversations with your children when you check their records via the SIMs App.</p>	<p>We agree and will be working with staff to improve the consistency of this and in turn make the information included in the SIMs App even more useful to you.</p>
<p>You asked whether the school has a specific “lock down” procedure for any emergencies.</p>	<p>We have a critical incident plan which covers all eventualities including evacuation and lock down. Copies of this policy are available on request. In addition, our Headteacher recently attended Critical Incident training to ensure we have the most up to date knowledge of best practice.</p>
<p>You wanted us to be aware that whilst you feel the introduction of the one way system was a positive, one of the main complaints from students is that not all staff follow the system which then undermines it.</p>	<p>We appreciate you sharing this feedback, this is something we will discuss as a staff team to ensure we are modelling the behaviours we expect of our young people.</p>
