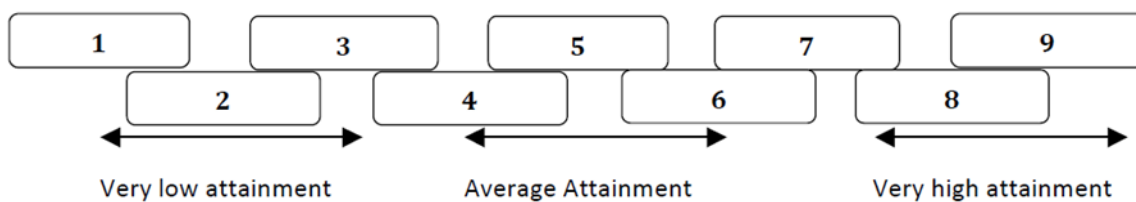


Understanding your child's report – Year 9 Summer 2016.

You have recently received your child's latest report and this contained new grades that you may not have seen before. As I am sure you are aware, the GCSE grades are changing. We are moving from the traditional letter grades (A*- G) to number grades (1-9). Not all GCSE grades are changing at the same time, as such the report you received will be a mixture of letter and number grades.

The subjects which have a number grade awarded to them are the new style GCSE's. Below is an idea of what these new grades mean as a guide for you.
